## ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research is to study the student participation in student activities of the Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang by classifying according to their personal problems and obstacles to the participation of 303 students in the Student Activities of the Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang. The tools used in this study were questionnaire which consisted 36 items. It was scale estimation questionnaire (Rating Scales) style. The researcher distributed 344 questionnaires. The 303 questionnaires were returned. It was 88.08 percent returned. The statistical analyses of data were percentage, average and standard deviation.

The results showed that:

1. Students in the Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang had opinions about participation in student activities as a whole at a high level (= 3.91), and when considered in each side, it was found that there were at a high level on all sides. The side with the average maximum was recreation (= 4.12), followed by sports and health promotions (= 4.08) and other (= 3.90), the promotion of arts and culture (= 3.79), academic (= 3.77). The average of the lowest was useful performing and environmental saving (= 3.75).

2. Male and female students had no different opinions about participating in student activities as a whole and each side.

3. The first to forth year students had no different opinions about participating in student activities as a whole. The upper forth year students had different opinions about participating in student activities. The first to forth year students had opinions at high level. However, The upper forth year students had opinions at medium level.

4. Students with different cumulative grade point average (GPA) had no different opinions about participating in student activities as a whole.

5. Students with different accommodation had no different opinions about participating in student activities as a whole.

6. From study of level of opinions of problems and obstacles to participation in students activities of students in the Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, it was found that undergraduate students of Faculty of Information Technology had opinions on what were problems and obstacles to participation in students activities of the Faculty by sorting according from the highest to lowest frequency as follows: the first was not the time to join by 200 students with 39.00 percent, followed by activities affect the course by 145 students with 28.30 percent, the activities were not interesting by 100 students with 19.50 percent, parents did not want them to participate too much by 49 students with 9.60 percent, the lowest frequency was others side by 19 students with 3.70 percent respectively.
