The purpose of this research was to survey the quality assurance of higher education in accordance with personnel viewpoints of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi. According to personnel's positions and faculties. The questionnaires used in this research were designed under the quality assurance conceptual framework of The Ministry of University Affairs as the following: (1) Philosophy, Commitments, Objectives and Implementation Plan, (2) Teaching and Learning, (3) Student Development Activities, (4) Research, (5) Academic Service to the Community, (6) Preservation of Arts and Culture, (7) Administration and Management, (8) Finance and Budgeting, and (9) QA System and Mechanism. The questionnaires were sent to 148 academic staff and 92 supporting staff members. The data were obtained from a set of questionnaires having a reliability of 0.9878. The data was then analysed with different modes including percentage, mean, standard deviation, the t-test, and F-test.

The results of the study were

- 1. The quality assurance of higher education in all aspects was at moderate level, Preservation of Arts and Culture was at low level.
- 2. Student Development Activities and Preservation of Arts and Culture were statistically different at 0.05 level.
- 3. No statistical difference was found in Philosophy, Commitments, Objectives and Implementation Plan, and Research at 0.05 level, but statistical difference was found in other aspects at 0.05 level.
