

Phornramphai Jaemjamras 2011: A Study of the Relationship between Language, Writer's World View and Writer's Personality in Nirat Soonthornpoo Literary Work. Master of Arts (Thai Language), Major Field: Thai Language, Department of Thai Language. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Chalor Rodloy, M.A.T. 282 pages.

This thesis is aimed at studying the language usage: using words to show the feeling of people, Reduplication, Rhyme in syllables and vowels, Figures of speech and studying writer's world view and writer's Personality in Nirat Soonthornpoo Literary Work.

The collected data in this study was 9 stories from Nirat Soonthornpoo Literary Work.

The results of this thesis are divided into 2 parts: language usage, writer's world view. In the first language usage part comprised of word selection to show feeling from personality which are pleasure feeling, happiness, freshness from nature touch, despair from losing the loved ones, sad emotion, anger, humor, sarcastic, funny emotion, being considerate for others. In addition, the thesis shows usage of reduplication from coward, lonely personality. Moreover, rhyme in syllables and vowels to show curiosity personality and admiring nature personality are found, Furthermore, figures of speech: onomatopoeia showing curiosity from animal personality and its sound, musical instrument sound admiring personality. Besides, there is usage of simile, personification to show curiosity, personality with comparable function. In the second part of this thesis showed 9 writer's world view: admiring love worth writer's world view, king admiring writer's world view, realism writer's world view, existentialism writer's world view, uncomfortable feeling writer's world view, disappointing feeling writer's world view, omniscient writer's world view which pay attention to history and be ready to pass on knowledge to others. writer's world view of norms for living idea which is ready for transmission to others. Respecting holy sacred item and supernatural writer's world view. The last writer's world view is about dreamy personality and its considerations.
