

Ratchanee Ruksasri 2010: The Construct of Appropriate Occupation Courses for Additional Teaching Mathayomsuksa 3 Students at Songphinong Municipal School, Suphan Buri Province. Master of Education (Vocational Education Development), Major Field: Vocational Education Development, Department of Vocational Education. The purposes of this study were to: 1) explore appropriate occupations for additional teaching of Mathayomsuksa 3 students at Songphinong Municipal School, Suphan Buri Province. 2) construct the appropriate occupational course for additional teaching Mathayomsuksa 3 students at Songphinong Municipal School, Suphan Buri Province. The population for this study was 103 teachers, school committee and students' parents. The study instruments were questionnaire, semi-structured interview, and data note. The data was qualitatively and quantitatively analyzed.

The research have revealed as follows:

1. The appropriate occupation for additional teaching to Mathayomsuksa 3 students at Songphinong Municipal School, Suphan Buri province, were Nang-Fa mushroom culture and computer technicians
2. The appropriate occupational course for additional teaching Mathayomsuksa 3 students at Songphinong Municipal School was Nang-Fa mushroom culture. The main purpose of this course which composes of 20 hours learning was to focus on practical knowledge.
