

Phramaha Wannachai Dapeang 2008: Synthesis of Knowledge on Buddhism Issues.
Doctor of Philosophy (Curriculum and Instruction), Major Field: Curriculum and

The objectives of the study were 1) to collect questions about Buddhism of
students at the grade ranges 2-4 in schools in Nakhon Phanom Province; 2) to synthesize
the knowledge on Buddhism issues for students at the grade ranges 2-4.

The study was a descriptive research consisting three steps 1) an identification of
topics and issues 2) an interview with experts on Buddhism and 3) a collection and
synthesis of questions and answers

The samples used were 1174 students from grade ranges 2-4 from six schools in
Nakae and Thatphanom District. The instruments used in collecting data were questionnaire
and interview form, Frequency was used for data analysis.

The findings were as follows : 1) The students at the grade range 2 posted the
question on ceremony and beliefs the most; the students at the grade range 3 posted the
question on merits and sin the most and the students at the grade range 4 posted the
question on Buddhism the most. 2) There were 111 questions arranged 7 groups in 1)
Buddhism 2) Lord Buddha 3) Monks 4) Merits and Sins 5) Hell and Heaven 6) Ghost, Mind and
Spirits 7) Ceremony and Beliefs.

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
