

Rungthip Suksupreecha 2011: A Synthesis of Master's Degree Theses in the Educational Research and Evaluation Program, Faculty of Education, Kasetsart University. Master of Education (Educational Research and Evaluation), Major Field: Educational Research and Evaluation, Department of Education. The purpose of this research was to synthesis on thesis of Master's Degree in the Educational Research and Evaluation Program, Faculty of Education, Kasetsart University during the academic years 2535-2551. The populations were 138 theses. The research tools consisted of synthesis record forms. The data were collected through by qualitative synthesis. The data were analyzed by frequencies and percentages.

The results indicated: 1) The data base on research: The purposes mostly studied of Current situation, Problems and Needs 53.01%. The data of the tools mostly were reported in an appendix 23.10%. 2) The content of research: The research design mostly employed Descriptive research 69.46% and the design mostly was Survey method 49.45%. The lower were Measurement researches 19.85% and the Evaluation researches were the least 10.69%. 3) The instructional process of research: The subjects were used in students of primary school 45.35%. The concept frame work designs mostly were descriptive 54.39%. The sampling mostly were multistage random sampling design 34.88%. The research instrument mostly formulated by the researcher 94.75% and the interview forms mostly were constructed 31.92%. The five of specialists mostly were checking of the tools quality 46.02% and the tools were tried out just one time 65.49%. The data mostly was collected by the researcher 82.61%. and were analyzed by percentages 29.95%. The disputation mostly was used by concepts theories and researches 75.18%. The directions mostly were used and innovated knowledge 97.83%. The reference books mostly were printed between 0-5 years while the researches were working 42.04%. 4) The result of research: The target people to used of the findings mostly were the group of teachers/professors 37.15%
