Execution of judgements or orders may affect third person's rights. Especially, in the case that seized property in order to sale by auction by executing officer does not belong to judgement debtor. Thus the laws of civil procedure provides opportunity for interested third person to file a request with the court in order to release the seized property.

In this thesis, the author studies and analyzes concepts and criterion related to the request for release of the property seized in Thailand. The study finds that the code's provisions and their enforcement are defective and so imprecise that they generate many problems. These problems were realized and the attempted for improvement took place. However, this thesis finds that there are some serious problems and recent improvement did not solve those problems, both in theoretical level and in practical enforcement.

In the final part of this thesis, the author concludes and proposes the suitable methods and means to solve these problems.
