International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from ships, 1973 Protocol 1978 International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage 1969 and Protocol 1976, International Convention Relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Cases of Oil Pollution Casualities, 1969 and International on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 and Protocol 1976. In order to solve what problems arising out and caused by maritime oil pollution and for solve of Thailand only to accommodate oil herself being listed by which active conventions to join.

Resulting from this studies, the writer explores that the Internation Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships, 1973 and Protocol 1978 and International Convention Relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Case of Oil Pollution Casualities, 1969 are coping with the solution to solve martime oil pollution which has been appropriated for Thailand to ractify and being listed under such Convention and Protocols.
