The challenge against the result of the election is a measure aiming at the abolition and the correction of the undue election.

It is apparent that rules and processes to challenge against the result of the election in the Election Act B.E. 2522 sections 78, 79 and 80 are not enough appropriate; that is it cannot protect and void a corrupt or illegal election. Some offences are not the grounds for bringing of a challenge. Furthermore, it limits the petitioner only for elector and the candidate in that specific constituency, including the party that presents its members as candidates in that constituency. Besides, to assign a court of justice for trial of an election challenge case and to bring about the Civil Procedure Code for trial by analogy, has caused a trial take longer time than it should be, which in fact is necessarily to fasten. It also confuses the opinion and distract the trial's resolution.

Therefore, it is necessary to amend the Election Act by permitting the bringing of a challenge against election without any limitation of the petitionner and the grounds for bringing such challenge. A suitable justice body should also be established with a suitable legal process for election challenge trial.
