

Sasinan Lamdapphong, Police Lieutenant 2008: Morale at Works of Immigration Police at Suvarnabhumi Airport. Master of Arts (Political Science), Major Field: Political Science, Department of Political Science and Public Administration. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Jatuporn Banchuen, M.S.S. 130 pages.

The purposes of this research were to study the level of morale at works of Immigration Police, to compare the morale at works according to personal characteristics, to study the relationship between organization climate and the morale at works and to study factors affecting working morality of Immigration Police. The research's sample size was 256 officers who worked at Suvarnabhumi Airport in position of sub-inspector and squad leader. The questionnaires were used as a tool to collect data. Analyzing data was processed by computer program. Statistical tools employed for data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, One -Way ANOVA, Pearson's production moment correlation coefficient and stepwise multiple regression analysis, at the .05 level of significance.

The research result found that the level of morale at works was moderate and the Immigration Police at Suvarnabhumi Airport had moderate level of perception of organization climate. The difference gender of Immigration Police had difference of morale at works. There was a positive correlation significantly between organization climate and the morale at works. And factors affecting the morale at works of Immigration Police at Suvarnabhumi Airport were organization structure, the support of the chance for seminar and development, the freelance of working, time span of working at Immigration Bureau, and male.
