

Pawita Wattanapiromsakul 2010: Parents' Expectation Towards Educational Management of Private Kindergarten School at Wiang Sa District in Surat Thani Province. Master of Education (Early Childhood Education) Major Field: Early Childhood Education, Department of Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Pattamavadi Lehmongkol, Ph.D. 114 pages.

The objective of this the study was to investigate parents' expectation towards educational management of private kindergarten school at Wiang Sa district in Surat Thani province. The subjects were 366 parents of preschool children studying in kindergarten level 1-3, second semester year of 2009. The questionnaire on parents' expectation towards educational management of private kindergarten schools at Wiang Sa district in Surat Thani province was the instrument of the study. The data were analyzed by percentage, standard deviation, and mean score.

Results indicated that the majority of the subjects were female ranging in age between 31-35 year old, having a career in agriculture having secondary education. Parents' expectation towards educational management of private kindergarten schools were as follows: 1) expectation provided through a variety of activities, children should have the opportunity to make decision, to get response, to practice in cooperating morality and ethics in appropriate opportunity; 2) instructional materials : parents expected that instructional materials should enhance physical, emotional, social, and cognitive development; 3) teachers : parents expected that teachers should have personality, polite words, complete and clear conversation with children; 4) student services : parents expected that bathrooms and toilets should be hygienic and sufficient provided; 5) physical environment provision : parents expected that bed sets such as mattresses, bed sheets pillow and pillow case should be clean and sufficient for children; 6) school and parent relationship : parents expected that orientation should be organized in order to inform objectives, procedures, regulations, and agreements on instruction; 7) evaluation : parents expected that children development follow up should be provided.
