

Sainapa Thakang 2010: The Opinions of Staffs in Chester Grill Restaurants through Training in Basic Operations Course of Chester Food Company Limited. Master of Education (Business Education), Major Field: Business Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Mrs. Methinee Wongwanich Rumpagaporn, Ed.D. 102 pages.

The purpose of this research was to study staffs' opinions in Chester Grill Restaurants through training in Basic Operations Course of Chester Food Company Limited. The study was operated in five aspects, including 1) content of curriculum 2) training process 3) training period 4) training evaluation and 5) training benefits. The research populations were 67 Staffs who participated in Basic Operations Course in year 2009. The data collection instrument were questionnaire that have been returned 65 questionnaires (around 97.01 % of research population). The data were analyzed by Frequency, Percentage, Mean, and Standard Deviation.

The research results have been demonstrated that most of staffs who participated in Basic Operations Course in 2009 rated the appropriateness of the Basic Operations Course at 'high' level both overall results and five aspect results from the 5 point rating scales; highest, high, moderate, low, and lowest .
