

Wichian Buabarn 2006: Opinions of the Official at the Secretariat of the Senate regarding to Self-development. The purpose of this study was to examine opinions of the official at the Secretariat of the Senate regarding to self-development. The study focused on a level of the opinions of the official at the Secretariat of the Senate regarding to self-development; comparing the opinions of the official at the Secretariat of the Senate regarding to self-development according to personal factors; and a relationship between work factors and opinions of the official at the Secretariat of the Senate regarding to self-development.

A group of sample was taken from 250 officials at the Secretariat of the Senate. An instrument to collect data was questionnaire. An instrument to analyze data was a personal computer with statistics software. Statistics includes percentage, arithmetic means and standard deviation, one-way ANOVA and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficients. The statistical significance was set at .05.

Studied results indicated that overall the level of the opinions, regarding to self-development of the official at the Secretariat of the Senate, was high; the level of the opinions, regarding to work factors of the official at the Secretariat of Senate, was moderate. In testing hypothetical questions, there were no difference in all the personal factors, except in age, and there were relationship between the work factors and the opinions of the official at the Secretariat of the Senate regarding to self-development.
