

Suteera Moondee 2010: Opinions of Tambon Working Groups on the Role of Water Resources Management in Huai Kraseaw Watershed Suphan Buri Province. Master of Arts (Social Development), Major Field: Social Development, Interdisciplinary Graduate Program. Thesis Advisor: Professor Nipon Tangtham, Ph.D. 122 pages.

The objectives of this research were comparing the view of the workers in Tambon level to their roles in managing water resources differentiate by their personal factors and to study correlation between their knowledge, their openness to the information this field and the opinions of tambon working group to their roles. The sampling of this study are 158 members from 16 teams of the workers on 16 Tambon in Huai kraseaw watershed. And use percentage, Mean, Standard Deviation, t-Test, F-test and Pearson Correlation at significant level of  $\alpha = 0.05$  as statistical analysis tools.

The study found that mostly of the samplings age are between 51-60 year. Their education level are primary, income are between 5,000-10,000 bath and positioned on the worker team of tambon steer. In general, they got high level in knowledge managing water resources, medium level in openness to the information from several kinds of media while got high level in expression their opinion to their role in managing water resource.

In testing hypothesis among dependent factors and independent factor, we found that the differential between age and education occupation, income and position have no influence to their views. Besides this, we also found that there are no correction between knowledge, the openness to the information and their managing water resource which against to the hypothesis.
