



Monchaya Onruang 2007: The Opinion of Lawyers to the Regulation of the Lawyers Council on Conduct of Lawyers Act B.E. 2529. Master of Arts (Political Science), Major Field: Political Science, Department of Political Science and Public Administration. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Naunjun Tasanachaikul, M.A., Thai Bars. 95 pages.

The objective of this research were to study the factor of individual, impression of occupation and the opinion on the level of lawyers to the Regulation of the Lawyers council on conduct of Lawyers Act B.E. 2529. The subjects of this study were lawyers from 146 lawyers with training on compound dispute (region 1) selected by purposive sampling method. Data were collected by using questionnaire as a tool. Statistics used in analyzes were percentage, mean, standard deviation and presentation by cross-tabulation.

The results of personal factor indicated that 63.2 % of lawyers, age 45 years old and above. The education higher than Bachelor degree had 85.0%. The barrister-at-law had 30 %. The permanent licensee lawyers had 76.1 % and 49.3 % of the experimental of hold a brief more than 10 years. The result of consideration to the Opinion of Lawyer to the Regulation of the Lawyers council on conduct of Lawyers B.E.2529 found that sex, age, education, a barrister-at-law, classification of licensee and experimental to hold a brief had different opinion; therefore male agree less than female. The age of lawyers more than 45 years old and the barrister-at-law disagree with another group. The impression of occupation in high level had opinion more than impression of occupation in low level.
