

Suratchada Yenchan 2010: The Opinions of Students toward Learning and Teaching Basic Business Subjects of the Fourth Level at Thammasart Klongluang Wittayakom School, Pathumthani Education Service Area 1, Ministry of Education. Master of Education (Business Education), Major Field: Business Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Yos Subyen, M.A. 102 pages.

The purpose of this research was to study the opinions of students toward learning and teaching basic business subjects of the fourth level at Thammasart Klongluang Wittayakom School, Pathumthani Education Service Area 1, Ministry of Education in 4 aspects : content, teacher, learning and teaching activities, and learning environment. The sample group consisted of students who were studying the fourth level at Thammasart Klongluang Wittayakom School, with a total of 125 students. Questionnaires were employed in this study for a data collection. Data were analyzed by a computer software. Descriptive statistics such as frequency, percentage, mean, standard deviation, and f-test were used for a data analysis.

The results of this study showed that the opinions of students toward learning and teaching basic business subjects of the fourth level at Thammasart Klongluang Wittayakom School in overall aspects were medium level. For the aspects of content, teacher, learning and teaching activities, the opinions of the students were at high level but in the aspects of learning environment were at medium level. The results indicated that students of Thammasart Klongluang Wittayakom School in fourth level with different grade, overall had different opinions. For the aspects of learning and teaching activities were different. However, they had similar opinions in content, teacher and learning environment.
