Abstract

The purposes of this invetigation were to study religious affairs administration and to find administrative problems and obstacles of district education officers in the Educational Region 8. The population under study comprised 99 district education officers, 71 education officers and 27 officers who were responsible for religious affairs from district offices. The instrument used in collecting the data was rating scale questionnaire. Percentage was used in data analysis.

The findings indicated that district education officers performed their tasks in the high level concerning management of data and information aspect of religious affairs administration. As for

coordination, planning, follow-up, evaluation and reporting; they were found in the moderate level. With respect to problems and obstacles; the followings were reported: insufficient manpower, insufficient budget and lack of materials. Moreover, monks did not have a chance to participate in project planning, follow-up, evaluaion and reporting.
