

Rujima Jomgthep 2011: Opinions of Supervisors and Colleagues to Staffs who Attended the Training Course under Governmental Aids for Administrative Assistants in School Project of Pathumthani Primary Education Authority II in Pathumthani Metropolitan. Master of Education (Business Education), Major Field: Business Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Mrs. Methinee Wongwanich Rumpagaporn, Ed.D. 109 pages.

The purpose of the current study was to determine the opinions of supervisors and colleagues to staffs who attended the training course under Governmental Aids for Administrative Assistants in School Project of Pathumthani Primary Education Authority II in Pathumthani Metropolitan. Five aspects were studied, including 1) knowledge 2) the ability and skills 3) the attitude 4) personality and character and 5) the motivation to work. The research samples in this study were supervisors and colleagues of staffs who attended the Training Course under Governmental Aids for Administrative Assistants in School Project. Totally 230 persons by using purposive sampling selection. The research instrument was used to collect the data which was questionnaire, data were analyzed by computer program. The statistics of analysis were frequency, percentage, mean and standard deviation. The results of the study were supervisors and colleagues gave their opinions at the highest level in three aspects, including attitude, motivation to work, and personality and character. However, they were two aspects at high level, including ability and skills, and knowledge. Furthumore, supervisors and colleagues gave their more opinions that Governmental Aids for Administrative Assistants in School Project could reduce their administrative burden and decrease workload of teachers and the school. This project is able to respond to the main objectives of the project. It is essential that the government should focus and support continuously to improve educational development of the country. It would enhance the quality of education in Thailand to expand internationally.
