## ABSTRACT

The research on establishment of self-agricultural processed-product network group a case study at Tambon Janvan, Ging Amphoe Sri Narong, Changwat Surin had the following objectives: 1) to study agricultural group's conditions and needs in processing agricultural products: and 2) to look for ways in the development of processed-product network group leading to community's self-sufficiency. The research stages consisted of a study of related problems to the group's needs prior to the analysis so as to set ways for the organizing of intervening activities for awareness of establishment and group development in processing agricultural products. Intervening activities consisted of training sessions, study tours, performances and supervision through a sample group of women in 4 villages: Ban Daeng, Ban Pran, Ban Tanon and Ban Janvan, Ging

Amphoe Sri Narong, Changwat Surin, 20 Women from each village, thus totalling 80 as an experimental group.

The study results indicated that:

- 1) Women had more awareness of establishment and group development as well as of processing agricultural products after intervening activities had been conducted.
- 2) Agricultural processed-product group extended its network to 3 more neighboring villages. This was to conclude that the organizing of intervening activities according to ways of this research could be adjusted to develop the women group's awareness.
