ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were: 1) to study the current situation, problems and needs of the project operation, 2) to compare moral behaviors of the novices between the expected moral behavior after training and pre-training moral behavior, 3) to propose a model of the appropriate operation. Sample group included 32 abbots, 66 resource persons, 438 novices, 438 novice parents and 19 superintendents. Five types of questionnaire were used for data collection then statistically analyzed to acquire percentage, \overline{X} , S.D. and t-test.

Findings:

1. Majority of the participants superintendents hold the religious degree on three grades of Dharma graduate. District educator are in their post less than six years and have at last

undergraduate study. The average age of the novice parents were 36-45 years old. The lowest educational attainment of the novices in pathom six and the highest was secondary school graduate. Problems that the project had encountered were planning and coordination; scheduling; medias and financial supports. The abbots requested financial support from the government, particularly the novice allowance of 100 bath per head. In addition, they needed the superintendents to visit, to supervise and to advice on program management. They also needed outsider trainers and medias.

- 2. Statistics show the significant differences in ethical expectation among the trainers befor and after the training program particularly in 5 domains:- 1) Buddhist relation 2) Moral development 3) Buddhism in heritance 4) Traditional and cultural preservation and 5) Populace responsibility. (P = 0.01)
- 3. A model of the appropriate operation consisted of planning, proposing project, public relation, operation and reporting.
