

The purposes of this research were to study and to compare the perceptions of the administrators, instructors, and students towards the student personnel services at Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok Campuses on five different categories namely : the orientation, the counseling, the records and statistics, the general services, and the student scholarships. The sample of the study consisted of 386 administrators, instructors, and students at Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok Campuses in the second semester of the academic year B.E. 2534 (1991). The 77 items of Likert questionnaires were used as an instrument of the study. The 96.73 % of the completed questionnaires were returned. The average means, standard deviation, F-test and Scheffe' test were used to analyse the data.

The findings of the study were as follows:

1. From the point of view of the administrators, instructors and students, student personnel services in general were at the moderate level, and all other categories were also moderately appropriate.

2. The perceptions of the administrators, instructors and students were not significantly different. For the counseling aspect, their perceptions were significantly different at .05. Specifically, the administrators, perceptions towards this category were better than the students.
