

The purposes of this research were to study the lifestyle of the elders at out patient department of Ramathibodi Hospital and to compare with the following variables; sex, age, religion, education level, marital status, living situation, occupation, income, capital source and residence. The sample were 206 elders which consisted of 92 males and 114 females. Their ages were 60 at least. The instrument was lifestyle interviewed rating scale. The data was analysed by t-test, one-way analysis of variance and Newmann-Keuls test.

The results were as follow :

1. The elders had lifestyle at good level.

2. There was no significantly statistical different lifestyle between male and female elders.

3. There were significantly statistical different lifestyle among different ages of the elders at .05 level.

4. There was significantly statistical different lifestyle between Buddhism and other religion at .05 level.

5. There were significantly statistical different lifestyle among different educational level of the elders at .001 level.

6. There were significantly statistical different lifestyle among different marital status of the elders at .001 level.

7. There were significantly statistical different lifestyle among different living situation of the elders at .001 level.

8. There were significantly statistical different lifestyle among different occupation of the elders at .001 level.

9. There were significantly statistical different lifestyle among different income of the elders at .001 level.

10. There were no significantly statistical different lifestyle among different capital source of the elders.

11. There was no significantly statistical different lifestyle between Bangkok resident and other resident.
