

Independent Study Title : Performance and Needs for Task Development
of Northern Region Border Patrol Police
School Administrators

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Abstract

The objectives of this study were : 1) to examine administrative performance situations of northern region border patrol police school administrators ; and 2) to identify their needs for school administration improvement. All 37 administrators of the 37 BPP. schools in Thailand's Upper North helped correspond to the rating scale questionnaire asking them how they viewed what they were doing and what they needed to help improve what they were doing. Statistical procedures used were percentage, average and standard deviation.

Findings were as follows :

1) In general, administrators were found to perform their duties in every aspect of school administration. The performance was rated in a "high level" category. Plant and building administration

was ranked highest followed by community relations, clerical and finance, general administration, personnel, student affairs and academic affairs administration.

2) Administrators were found to most need improvement and support in their clerical and finance administration performance. They needed more budget to support their school works and its administration should be in the hand of school committees.
