

Kannikar Pornjaroensub 2007: Opinion on Nonmarrital Cohabitation before Marriage of Social Sciences Faculty Student's at Kasetsart University. Master of Arts (Development Social Sciences), Major Field: Development Social Sciences, Interdisciplinary Graduate Program. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Sakol Satitwityanan, Ph.D. 76 pages.

The Objectives of this thesis were to study 1) The opinion level on nonmarrital cohabitation before marriage of Social Sciences Faculty Student's at Kasetsart University 2) Compare of level opinion on nonmarrital cohabitation before marriage of Social Sciences Faculty Student's at Kasetsart University by individual factors and 3) Opinion advantage and disadvantage of nonmarrital cohabitation before marriage of Social Sciences Faculty Student's at Kasetsart University. The sample consisted undergraduate students in Faculty of Social Sciences, Kasetsart University of 308 students by multistage random sampling. Data were collected by questionnaires. The statistical used the data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, and F-test. The scheffe's test was employed to test the difference between various groups. The singnificant level was set at 0.05.

The result of the study found out that the opinion on nonmarrital cohabitation before marriage of student in Faculty of Social Sciences, Kasetsart University were moderate to low. Female student, first year student and reasonable lookafter family were low opinion level. But local living and living status of student not different opinion on nonmarrital cohabitation before marriage.
