

Treeyakarn Promkam 2010: The Opinion about Female Dormitory Chairman Student's Stress of Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus Affecting to the Academic Achievement. Master of Arts (Applied Sociology), Major Field: Applied Sociology, Department of Sociology and Anthropology. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Palanee Dhitiwatthana, M.Ed., MA. 131 pages.

The objectives of this research were as follows: 1) to study the stress of students on the role of the female dormitory chairman of Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus. 2) to study the opinion about the stress of the female dormitory chairman role whether it affects to academic achievement.

The Qualitative research supplemented by quantitative research methods were used. Questionnaire and open-ended questions were used to collect data from 280 female students who live in dormitory of Kasetsart University, while qualitative used in-depth interview were conducted with 8 female dormitory chairman. The data were collected and analyzed by using computer program. Statistics used in this research were Percentage, Mean and Standard Deviation.

The result of this study shown that students who are female dormitory chairman in Kasetsart University, Bangkok Campus had a high level of stress from their responsibility for dormitory. Most stress causes of those stress are from breaking regulations of student in their responsibility, caused from too much both works in meeting and caused from all activities. However, these stress that they have faced don't have any effect to their academic achievement because these fourth year students have a few subjects in class. Beside, their grade point average is good in those terms. So, all stress don't any effect for academic achievement of them.
