

Nunnapat Muangnoi 2011: People's Awareness on Parent's Quality of Life in Housing Estate of Tambol Bangrakpattana Administration Organization, Bang Bua Thong District, Nonthaburi Province. Master of Arts (Development Social Sciences), Major Field: Development Social Sciences, Faculty of Social Sciences. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Sakol Satitwityanan, Ph.D. 156 pages.

The objectives of this research were to study: 1) the level of people's awareness on parent's quality of life in housing estate of Tambol Bangrakpattana administration organization, Bang Bua Thong district, Nonthaburi province. 2) Compare the level of their awareness of parent's quality of life in terms of interpersonal variables. 3) The relationship between work place interaction and level of awareness. The sample consisted of 367, housing estate residents. Data were collected by questionnaires and analyzed by statistical methods, namely; percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, F-test and Pearson' Product Moment Correlation Coefficient at .05 level of significance.

The results showed that residents in housing estate had moderate to high level of awareness. As considering in details, psychosocial awareness was at high level, whereas economical status, basic needs and physiological stage had relation with awareness at moderate level. According to hypothesis, it was found that different level of education, occupation, salary, number of visiting home town, and number of sibling were aware at a statistic significance of .05 level while gender, age, marital status, and number of family member were not. However, relationship at work place had significantly positive relationships with the level of awareness at .05
