

Suree Pichalee 2010: Student's Desire for Guidance Service at Non – Formal and Informal Education Centre Lat Krabang District Bangkok. Master of Education (Vocational Education Development), Major Field: Vocational Education Development, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Mr. Sompop Suwannarat, Ph.D. 102 pages.

The objectives of this research were 1) to study and comparative the students' desire for guidance service at Non – Formal and Informal Education Centre Lat Krabang District and 2) to study the relationship between factors and personal factors and psychological characteristics of guidance desires of students, Lat Krabang District Non – formal and Informal Education Centre. The classification of personal factors such as gender, age, occupation, education level and psychological characteristics such as achievement motivation, self confidence, perceived problems and obstacles, attitude of guidance. 320 samples of the students Lat Krabang District Non – formal and Informal Education Centre the second term year of 2009 who came by means of stratified sampling. Tools used in this study was a questionnaire. Data were analyzed by using frequency, percentage, mean, standard deviation, Independent Sample t-test , One-way ANOVA and correlation.

The research findings were as follows:

1) Students' Desire for Guidance Service at Non – formal and Informal Education Centre Lat Krabang District was found all desires high level and students at Non – formal and Informal Education Centre Lat Krabang District by different individual factor comprised of gender, age, occupation education level, require different guidance statistically significant at the .05 level.

2) Personal factors did not correlate with the desires of the student guidance service.

3) Factors, psychological characteristics associated with guidance services desires of students statistically significant at the .01 level.
